Beware of the Lure of Life on Easy Street!

Subject: Two Ways to Respond to the Lure of Life on Easy Street

Complement:

With eyes on it *from your perspective now,* which results in envy, despair, cynicism, and doubt

With eyes on it *from God's perspective later*, which leads to renewed gratitude for the gift of God's eternal presence

- A. Plugging the Psalm into the Structure of the Book (its 'central,' threatens to take one of the track of Psalms 1 and 2 (via Ps 72).
- B. Selected Exposition, Part by Part (see translation)
